Kommunalkredit hires Christopherson

Vienna-based bank **Kommunalkredit** has hired project finance veteran *Tom Christopherson* from CEE Fund Advisory as a senior sales banker.

He will report to recent hire *Agnes Mazurek*, who joined Kommunalkredit as head of placement and sales from Macquarie.

Christopherson worked at Hamburg's CEE as a director in charge of analysis and portfolio management, advising a European infrastructure debt fund.

He has 30 years of project finance experience across structuring, syndication and asset management roles. He has held syndication jobs at the African Development Bank, NAB, Dresdner Kleinwort, Hypo-Bank and Bayerische Vereinsbank.

Kommunalkredit built up an infrastructure team over the past year led by banking head *John Philip Weiland*, previously head of infrastructure and energy syndication at Deutsche Bank. He joined the Austrian bank together with former Deutsche colleagues *Bernd Fislage* and *Joakim Forsberg*. The bank made other senior infrastructure hires from UniCredit, KPMG, HSH Nordbank and Macquarie (PFI 618).
